- Topic: teaching mobility in the context of the Erasmus+ programme















Background & challanges

Teachers

- are the engine of higher education (EC renewed agenda for higher education 2017)
- are a key factor in internationalisation strategies (Erasmus Impact Study 2014)
- play a crucial role in supporting student mobility and credit recognition (REALISE)

However

- teaching mobility remained a rather unexplored area
- organisational difficulties 8 hour spot
- staff mobility for teaching is often not of sufficient quality and not easily accessible for (especially junior) teaching staff



Research

- despite its strategic importance and possible impacts,
 outcomes assessment of staff mobility strongly focuses on input and output indicators and lacking important
 contextual and process elements
- a more rigorous and complex measurement regarding the topic is needed, e.g. from a quality assurance perspective
- taking into consideration personality factors and the pedagogical dimension as well








Catalogue of pedagogical tools and methods

- the use of innovative pedagogical tools and methods have a significant impact on the quality of teaching mobility




