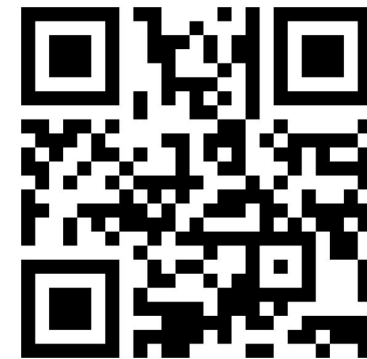

Recommendations for HEIs



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1 Adopt a strategic approach to teaching mobility

2 Promote teaching mobility among junior staff with strategic partner institutions

3 Improve and formalise recognition schemes

4 Make teaching mobility greener and more sustainable

5 Promote new spaces of digital networking

6 Encourage teachers to use innovative and inclusive digital solutions

7 Encourage blended and digital forms of teaching mobility

8 Provide preparatory training before applying to and taking up mobility

9 Provide assistance in administration

10 Design and implement clear, inclusive and targeted communication and promotion

11 Promote an inclusive outreach & engagement strategy to academic staff and an inclusive teaching & learning environment
